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Article Format/Template Guidelines

Submission Format

Accepted File Type: MS Word (.docx format only).

Page Limit: 2-5 pages, not exceeding 2000 words.

Font: Times New Roman.

Font Size: 12 for the main text.

Line Spacing: 1.5.

Section Organization: Your article should be divided into clearly defined and numbered sections. Subsections should be numbered (1, 2; then 1.1, 1.1.1, 1.1.2; 1.2, etc.). The abstract does not require section numbering.

Article Structure

- **Title:** Bold, Font Size 14, Centered.
- **Author(s) Name(s):** Italic, Centered.
- **Author's Affiliation:** Include email and/or ORCID ID, Italic, Centered.
- **Corresponding Author's Email ID.**

Abstract:

- Provide a concise, accurate summary of the article, highlighting the main topic and conclusions.
- Length: 120-180 words.

Keywords: List 3-5 relevant keywords following the abstract, selecting terms that are specific yet common within the field.

Introduction:

- Set the context for the work, outlining the problem and the motivation for addressing it.
- May consist of multiple paragraphs.

Body of Article:

- Detail the core aspects of your research or analysis, including methodology, results, and discussion, tailored to the subject of your paper.

Conclusion:

- Summarize the findings and suggest further research or implications.

Acknowledgements: (Optional) Recognize individuals or organizations that assisted in your research.

Figures, Illustrations, and Tables:

- Integrate directly into the text, with each labeled sequentially and accompanied by a caption in italics.
- Ensure legends and captions are self-explanatory.
- Figures should be high-resolution (>600 Dpi) and in JPG format. Select one image as the highlight for online publication.

References: Format according to APA style or as follows:

Journal Articles: Author Last Name, Initials. & Second Author's Last Name, Initials. (Year). Article title. Journal Name, Volume(Issue), pages.

Example: Smith, J., & Doe, J. (2024). The future of AI research. Journal of Computer Science, 50(2), 150-180.

Books: Author Last Name, Initials., & Second Author's Last Name, Initials. (Year). Book title. (Edition). Publisher.

Example: Smith, J., & Doe, J. (2024). The future of AI research. (3rd ed.). Technology Publishing.

Book Chapters: Author Last Name, Initials., & Second Author's Last Name, Initials. (Year). Chapter title. In Editor's Initials. Last Name & Second Editor's Initials. Last Name (Eds.), Book title (pp. pages). Publisher.

Example: Smith, J., & Doe, J. (2024). AI in healthcare. In A. Johnson & B. Stevens (Eds.), Advances in medical technology (pp. 152-196). Technology Publishing.

Theses/Dissertations: Author Last Name, Initials. (Year). Title of thesis [Doctoral dissertation, University Name]. Database or Archive Name.

Example: Smith, J. (2024). AI and machine learning: An empirical analysis [Doctoral dissertation, University of Technology]. Institutional Repository.

Patents: Inventor Last Name, Initials. (Year). Patent title. Patent Office. Patent No.

Example: Johnson, A. (2024). Advanced AI algorithms. U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. Patent No. US 10,123,456.

Websites: Author Last Name, Initials. (Year, Month Day). Page title. Website Name. URL

Example: Doe, J. (2024, Feb 2). Home. Agriculture. futureagriculture.co.in/Home
